Title of Lesson:

Law Enforcement and Homeless: Forging Partnerships

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Approving Authority:

Course Goal:

 Increase officers' basic understanding of the causes and prevalence of homelessness in the United States and locally. Increase knowledge on how to interact with a person experiencing homelessness.

Course Learning Objectives:

- Understand the causes of homelessness
- Understand the causes that lead to persistent homelessness
- Understand how to interact with a person experiencing homelessness
- Learn important resources for police officers

Methodology:

Participants will be taught by instructors with knowledge and experience interacting with people who experience homelessness. All trainers will come from agencies that provide services to people experiencing homelessness. A PowerPoint presentation will be presented to the trainees which includes an ice breaker, video, lecture, and discussion. An Instructor Manual will supplement the power point will serve as an instructional aid.
